DECLARATION OF CONFORMITY

At the issue from 13th February 2003, the official Journal of the European Union has waived the following:

GUIDELINE 2002/95/EG OF THE EUROPEAN PARLAMENT AND THE COUNCIL from 27th January 2003 for limitation of application of particular hazardous substances in electrical equipment.

(RoHS "Restriction of Hazardous Substances")

Article 4 (1)

"As from the 1st July 2006, the member states make sure, that all introduced electrical equipment **don't** contained lead, mercury, cadmium, sexavalent chrome, polybrominated biphenyl (PBB) and polybrominated diphenylether (PBDE). ..."

In conjunction with the adjudication of the European Commission from 18th August 2005 for the change of the addition at the guideline 2002/95/EG from the European Parliament and the Council for the purpose of the agreement for concentration limits of particular hazardous substances in electrical equipment. Article 1 (Official Journal of the European Union from 19.08.2005) (2005/618/EG)

The Guideline 2002/95/EG will be released with the "Law about putting on to the open market, the retraction and the environment-friendly disposal of electrical equipment (electrical equipment law – ElektroG) as from 16th March 2005, released at BGBI 2005, Part I, Nr17, Page 762ff, implemented in national law. Here: Paragraph 2, § 5 (1) substance prohibition.

Coollaboratory confirmed the conformity (GUIDELINE 2002/95/EG) of the product "Coollaboratory Liquid MetalPad", their amendment as well as the performed laws.
